

**AMONG VALLEYS, ROCKS AND MILLENARIAN FORESTS**

This nature trail connects San Sebastián de La Gomera with the beach of Vallehermoso, almost all its length crossing with the varied insular orography, dotted with rocks of forest - mountain; and the Canary pine forest, being able to contemplate the varied insular orography, dotted with rocks of laurel. The magnificient views of the Canarian humid forests from the area of the base layer; the thermophilic forest; the broad littoral areas Vallehermoso with its beach; the valley with path GR-13; While covering the stages of detail (bus) with the central plateau, with Garajonay National Park as its best example, makes this trail a must for your summer sessions.

#### FROM SAN SEBASTIÁN DE LA GOMERA TO DEGOLLADAS DE PERAZA

##### 1. From San Sebastián de la Gomera to Degolladas de Peraza

The first stage starts at San Sebastián de la Gomera, and the first 15 km run on the town. Leaving the town behind, the trail starts a strong ascent, doglegging up the side of El Lomo de las Vueltas, among tabaibas and balos, up to La Sabina or El Higueral. After Ayamsoña, the path alternates stone-paved and asphalt stretches until the Natural Monument of Barranco del Cabrito. Further on, you can admire the canyon of Las Lajas and see the villages of La Laja and Chejelipes. Finally, 6.9 kilometers into the trail, a path leads to the viewpoint of Degollada de Peraza.

#### FROM DEGOLLADAS DE PERAZA TO CHIPUDE

##### 2. From Degolladas de Peraza to Chipude

This section, 16.3 km long, crosses one of the areas with the highest natural value in the island: Garajonay National Park. Starting at the viewpoint of Degollada de Peraza, the trail reaches the Campos de las Nieves and the rest area of the hermitage of Las Nieves. Then, it continues among Canary Island pines and thick heaths, crossing wooden and metal walkways and the road GM-2. From the viewpoint of Los Roques, you can admire the cliffs of Benijigüa. Further on, from the viewpoint of Morro de Agando, all the Natural Monument of Los Roques can be admired. From the viewpoint of Tajaqué, you can admire the caldera of Benijigüa again, if the usual fog brought by the trade winds. The trail continues, offering

views over La Mulata, with the Agando took in the horizon, and arrives at the Pajarito roundabout. You will then go uphill until the Garajonay, which is the highest peak in the island, 1,487 meters high. On clear days, the neighboring islands of Tenerife, La Palma and even Gran Canaria can be seen. After this point, the path starts descending until it arrives at the village of Guadalupe and its viewpoint. Here you will find a monument to Gomeran whistle and a hermitage. From the viewpoint, you can admire the panoramic views over the cliff of Eque, within the Protected Landscape of Orotava, with the Natural Monument of the Fortaleza de Chipude on the background. This stretch ends at Chipude, after the China dam and Pavón.

#### FROM CHIPUDE TO VALLEHERMOSO

##### 4. From Chipude to Vallehermoso

The third stage is 14 km long and starts at the square of Chipude to cross the cliff of the Marañuelas until El Cercado. After crossing this town, a path leads to the cliff of El Agua, belonging to the Gran Rey Valley, where the namesake rural park is located. There is no doubt that this is the most stunning natural park of the cliffs of La Gomera. Following a short ascent, you will arrive on the rural town of Las Hayas, where you can take the Coromoto path and see the hermitage and rest area of this village before entering the Garajonay National Park again.

#### FROM VALLEHERMOSO TO VALLEHERMOSO BEACH

##### 5. From Vallehermoso to Vallehermoso Beach

From the center of Vallehermoso, you can continue the route continues up to the hermitage of El Carmen, where the trail starts doglegging downhill, flanked by the Cano rocks, until it arrives at the small rural village of La Rosa de Piedras, located in the Ingenio cliff, and the recreational area of the La Encantadora dam.

#### FROM VALLEHERMOSO TO VALLEHERMOSO BEACH

##### 6. From Vallehermoso to Vallehermoso Beach

After an ascent towards the Cano rocks, with said village, offering beautiful panoramic views over the Ingenio cliffs and their valley interspersed with Canarian palm trees and terraces. This stage ends at the town square of Vallehermoso. It is possible to connect with one of the stretches of the Costas de La Gomera Nature Trail.
