Send to destination safe for category





# Hazards in each category

## Category 1

- Risk of prions
- Risk of banned products or contamination

## Category 2

- Microbiological risk
- Residues of medicines

## Category 3

Origin of healthy animals





# Most frequently used authorized destinations

Feed (after processing)

Biogas, compost, fertilizer Incineration, Coincineration, Combustion

Burial

Cosmetics, Medicines, Medical devices

## Some other destinations

- Special feeding purposes
- For exhibitions, artistic activities, diagnostic, educational or research purposes
- Trade samples & display items
- Surgical intervention at farm disposal
- Biodynamic preparations
- Crisis measures

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# Ban for feeding

#### Cannibalism ban

- Terrestrial: PAP species X to species X
- PAP of farmed fish species Y to farmed fish species Y

### Catering waste ban

- To farmed animals
- Also derived from catering waste

## 21 days waiting period for OF/SI

- Access to pasture land
- Harvest feed materials





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# Flowchart Feeding ABP








